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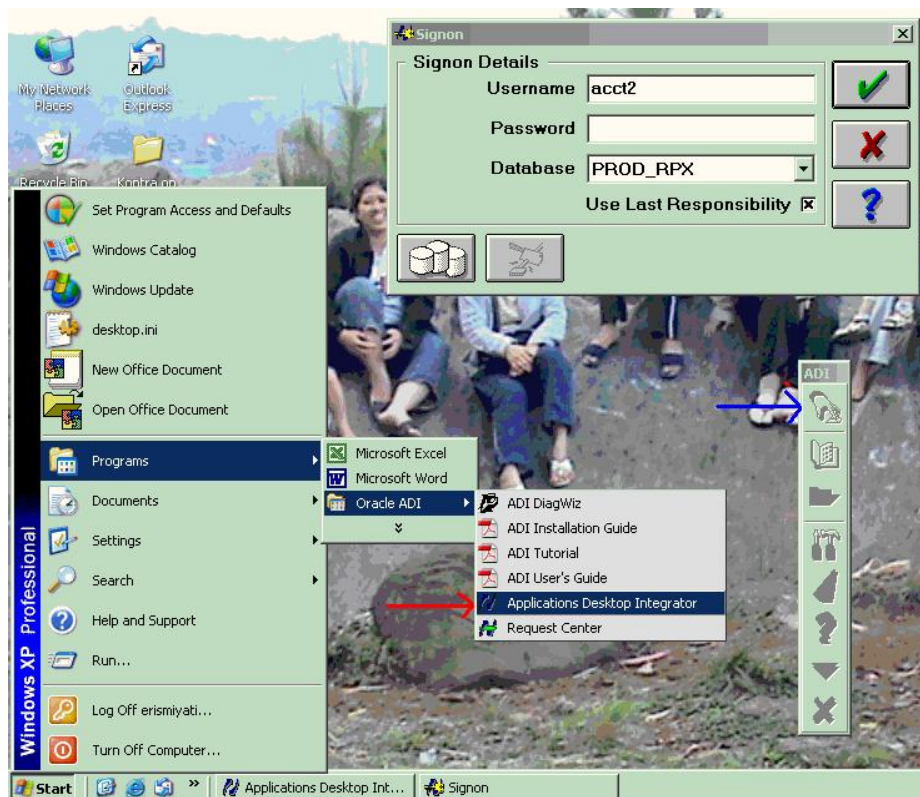

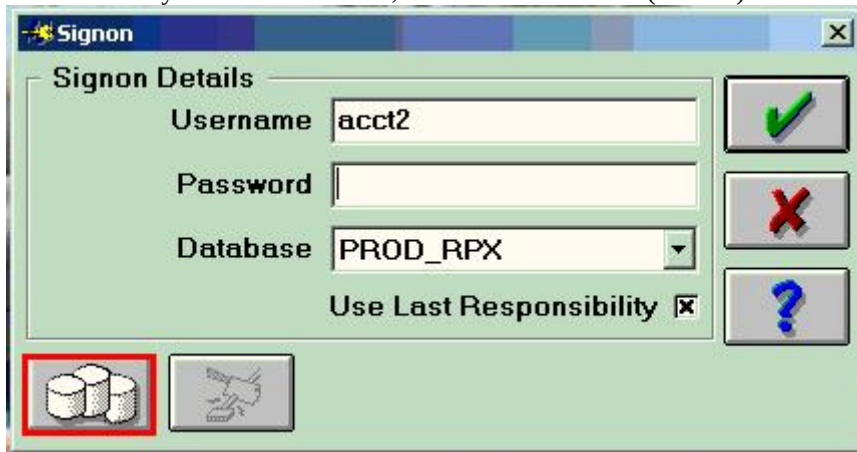
1. Download and extract file ADI7.2-installer.zip from
 - a. <http://10.10.105.105/data/ADI7.2-installer.zip>
 - b. <http://10.10.105.79/software/howto/ADI7.2-installer.zip>
2. Open folder ADI 7.2 and execute file p3966101_72_MSWIN.exe, install all component with default location.
3. Edit all files named "TNSNAMES.ORA" on folder C:\ORANT (use Find Files function) and add the following lines on the bottom:

PROD_RPX.world =  
(DESCRIPTION =  
  (ADDRESS_LIST =  
    (ADDRESS = (COMMUNITY = tcp.world) (PROTOCOL = TCP)(HOST =  
rpxorafin.rpxholding.com)(PORT = 1521))  
  )  
  (CONNECT_DATA =  
    (SID = ERPP)  
  )  
)
```

4. Run Oracle ADI, From Start >> Programs >> Oracle ADI >> Application Desktop Integrator (red arrow) and click Connect (blue arrow).

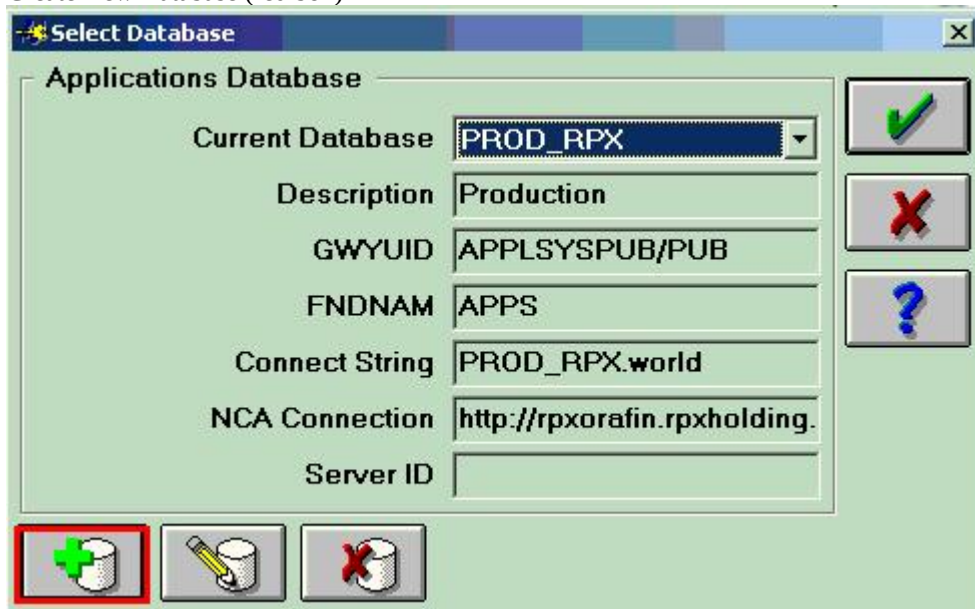


5. If ADI is newly installed on that PC, click Define Database (red box)



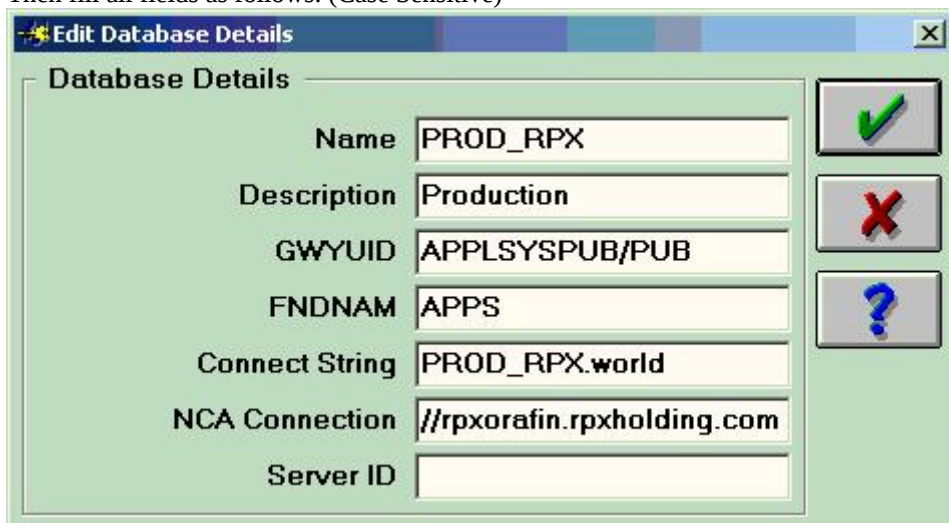
